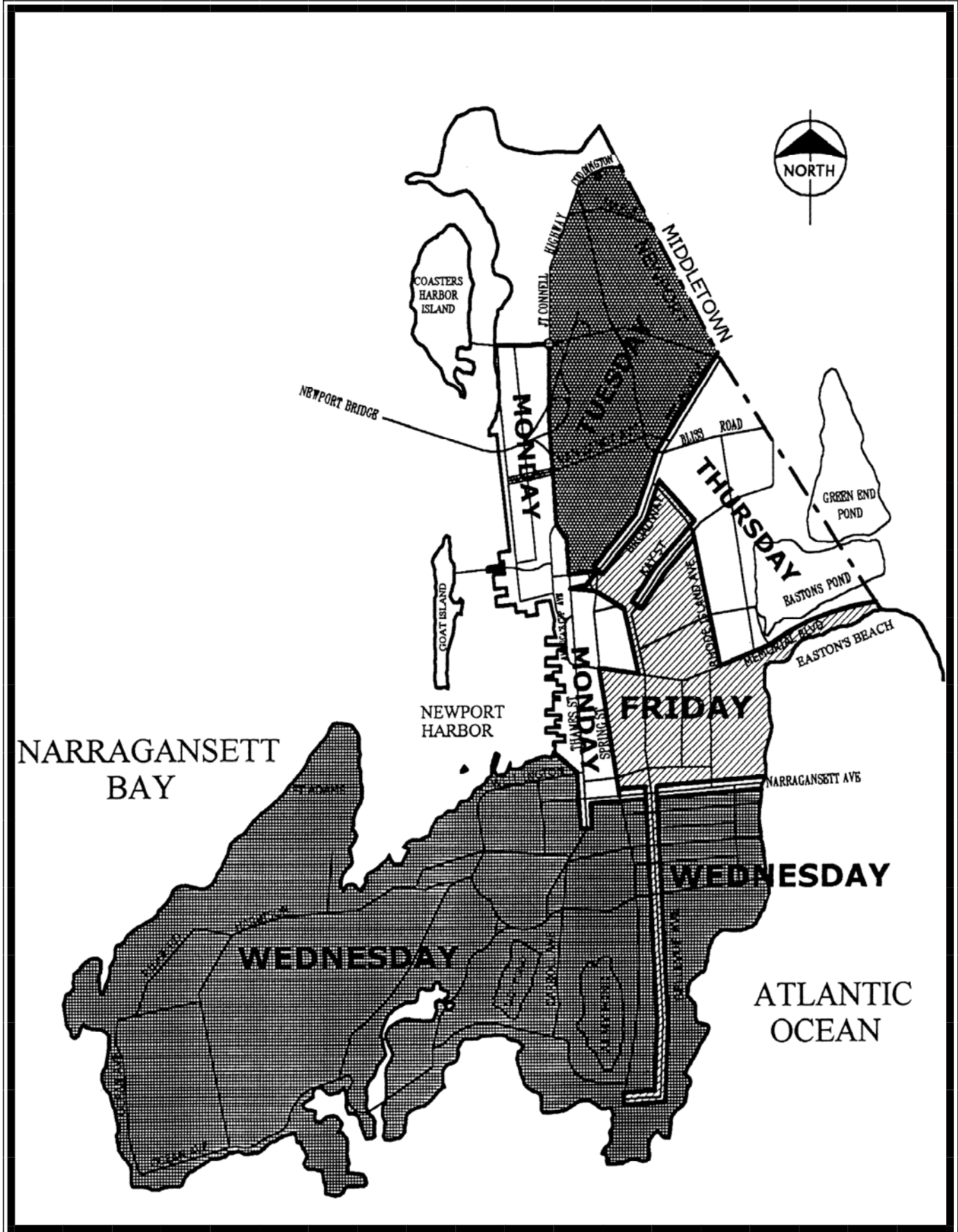

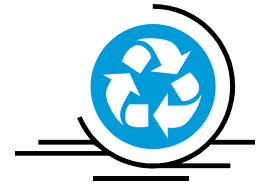

- Please find your collection day on the map. Trash, recycling and all other collections are scheduled on the same day.
- ***In case of a holiday, all collections will be delayed by one day.*** Saturday collections will only be made to compensate for a holiday occurring during the week. Please note, the following collections are **not** affected by the following holidays this year: President's Day Feb. 18th, and Rhode Island Independence Day, May 4th.

### **FOR YOUR BLUE BIN**

#### **METAL CANS & SCRAP METAL**

- Aluminum & tin cans
- Foil & pie plates
- **Empty** steel aerosol cans
- **Empty** latex paint cans
- Scrap metal
- Toasters, irons
- Wire hangers

#### **GLASS BOTTLES & JARS**

(Rinse; metal lids are recyclable)

- Mayonnaise jars
- Wine bottles
- Beer bottles
- Spaghetti sauce jars
- Salsa jars
- Vinegar bottles
- Baby food jars

#### **#1 PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS**

(Rinse; discard plastic lids)

- All plastic bottles & jugs with a #1 on the bottom
- Soda & juice bottles
- Salad dressing bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Window cleaner bottles
- Water bottles

#### **#2 PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS**

(Rinse; discard plastic lids)

- Colored and uncolored bottles with a #2 on the bottom
- Milk jugs
- Detergent bottles
- Juice bottles
- Saline solution bottles
- Fabric softener & bleach bottles

#### **DRINK CARTONS**

(Rinse; Throw away plastic straws)

- Milk & juice cartons
- Juice boxes
- Cream & creamer containers

#### **EXCEPTIONS:**

- **No oil-based paint cans**
- **No Household Hazardous Waste**
- No plastic bags (return them to the grocery store)
- No broken glass, plates, ceramics, Pyrex, light bulbs

### **FOR YOUR GREEN BIN**

#### **MIXED PAPER**

- Mail, envelopes (windows ok)
- Magazines, catalogs
- Phonebooks
- Writing paper
- Paperback books
- Paper bags
- Greeting cards
- Wrapping paper (no foil type paper)
- Shredded paper
- Computer/Copy/Fax paper

#### **NEWSPAPERS**

- All newspapers, ads, and inserts

#### **THIN CARDBOARD**

- Shoe boxes
- Cereal boxes
- Pasta boxes (windows ok)
- Toilet paper rolls
- Gift boxes
- Cake mix boxes
- Toothpaste boxes
- Tissue boxes
- Paper egg cartons

#### **CARDBOARD**

(Flatten & tie with a string. Bundles must be less than 3 ft long or wide. Place near recycling bin)

- Boxes & other corrugated cardboard (smooth on the outside, wavy in the middle)

#### **EXCEPTIONS:**

- Do not put paper in plastic bags
- No paper towels, tissues or napkins
- No take-out food containers such as **pizza boxes**
- No beer or soda packaging
- No boxes with silver or foil coatings
- Nothing dirty, greasy, waxed, or plastic-coated

**ALL TRASH MUST BE PLACED CURBSIDE IN BARRELS WITH TIGHTLY FITTING COVERS BY 6:00 A.M. TO BE COLLECTED.** Residents may put out the equivalent of six (6) thirty-two (32) gallon containers. *Containers are not to be set out earlier than 7 p.m. the night before collection.*

To Report a missed collection or to schedule an appointment for large metal items or appliances, call Waste Management Inc. at 847-0230.

**BULKY WASTE IS COLLECTED YEAR ROUND ON RESIDENTS' REGULARLY SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAY AND MUST BE SET OUT BY 6:00 A.M.**

Appointments are needed with your collection provider 24 hours in advance for large metal items and tires only. Call Waste Management at 847-0230 to schedule an appointment.

**YARD WASTE IS COLLECTED IN BROWN PAPER LEAF BAGS OR LOOSE IN TRASH BARRELS LABELED "YARD WASTE". YARD WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED IN PLASTIC BAGS.** See adjacent calendar for collection schedule. Yard waste includes leaves, grass, plant clippings and small sticks and branches. All sticks and branches less than 4ft. long, can either be placed in yard waste bags, yard waste-designated barrels, or tied in bundles. For free "Yard Waste Only" stickers please call the Clean City Program office at 845-5613.

**The Clean City Program accepts used motor oil, electronic waste, used books, flattened cardboard, clothing and other textiles . Call the Newport Clean City Program Office at 845-5613 for details, or stop by 70 Halsey Street, Monday through Friday to drop off items.**

**ELECTRONIC WASTE:** includes computers, printers, scanners, televisions, laptops, fax machines, cd-roms, dvd-roms, vcr's, audio equipment, video games, disc drives, modems, cards, keyboards, computer mice, electronic wires or plugs, pc speakers, recording, surveillance or camera equipment, digital cameras, cell phones & accessories, lcd products, and used ink jet cartridges

**BOOKS:** Any type or style of books will be accepted, including paperbacks, used textbooks, hardcover books, books on tape and DVD's. Magazines, phonebooks, and books with mold or mildew on them, are not able to be collected. The books should be packed securely in a cardboard box or carton with a lid, and not weigh more than 40lbs. Books should not be packed in plastic or paper bags as they may tear through them. All donations are tax deductible.

**CLOTHING:** A clothing collection container has been placed at the City's Department of Public Works, located at 70 Halsey Street, off of Admiral Kalbfus Road. Newport residents are welcome to drop off clothing, shoes, sheets, and blankets in the container. All donations are

### Transfer Station Use:

Newport property owners may take two loads a year, 500 pounds per load, to the Waste Management Inc. transfer station and are given a discount on any additional loads at the transfer station. Property owners must show proof of Newport home ownership by bringing either a tax or water bill when they stop at the scale house.
