

NEWPORT HARBOR ORDINANCES

Please be advised that a vessel's owner or captain is responsible for the safety of their vessel and complying with all applicable Newport Harbor Ordinances and laws, including the following:

- Newport Harbor is a **NO DISCHARGE ZONE**. Fines range from \$500-\$1,000 (Code 46-12-39)
- The speed limit in the harbor is **5 MPH**.
- The harbor is a **NO WAKE ZONE**
- Vessels are prohibited from anchoring in open channels or the mooring fields. The captain of any anchored vessel must stay within proximity of the vessel in case of heavy weather. Also, the captain is responsible for proper ground tackle and anchoring technique.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- US Post Office is located across the street from Hammett's Wharf Hotel at the intersection of Memorial Blvd. and America's Cup Avenue.
- Water is available on the Water Dock, located in the northeast corner of the harbor, near Newport Harbor Hotel and Marina.

ANCHORAGE FIELDS

The City anchorage is marked on the south end of the harbor, just south of the main east-west channel as you enter the harbor from Fort Adams. There are two federal anchorages, one is directly north of Goat Island, and the other is directly west of Goat Island.

NOTE: Per City Ordinance, boats may anchor for 14 consecutive days. Stay clear of cable markers.

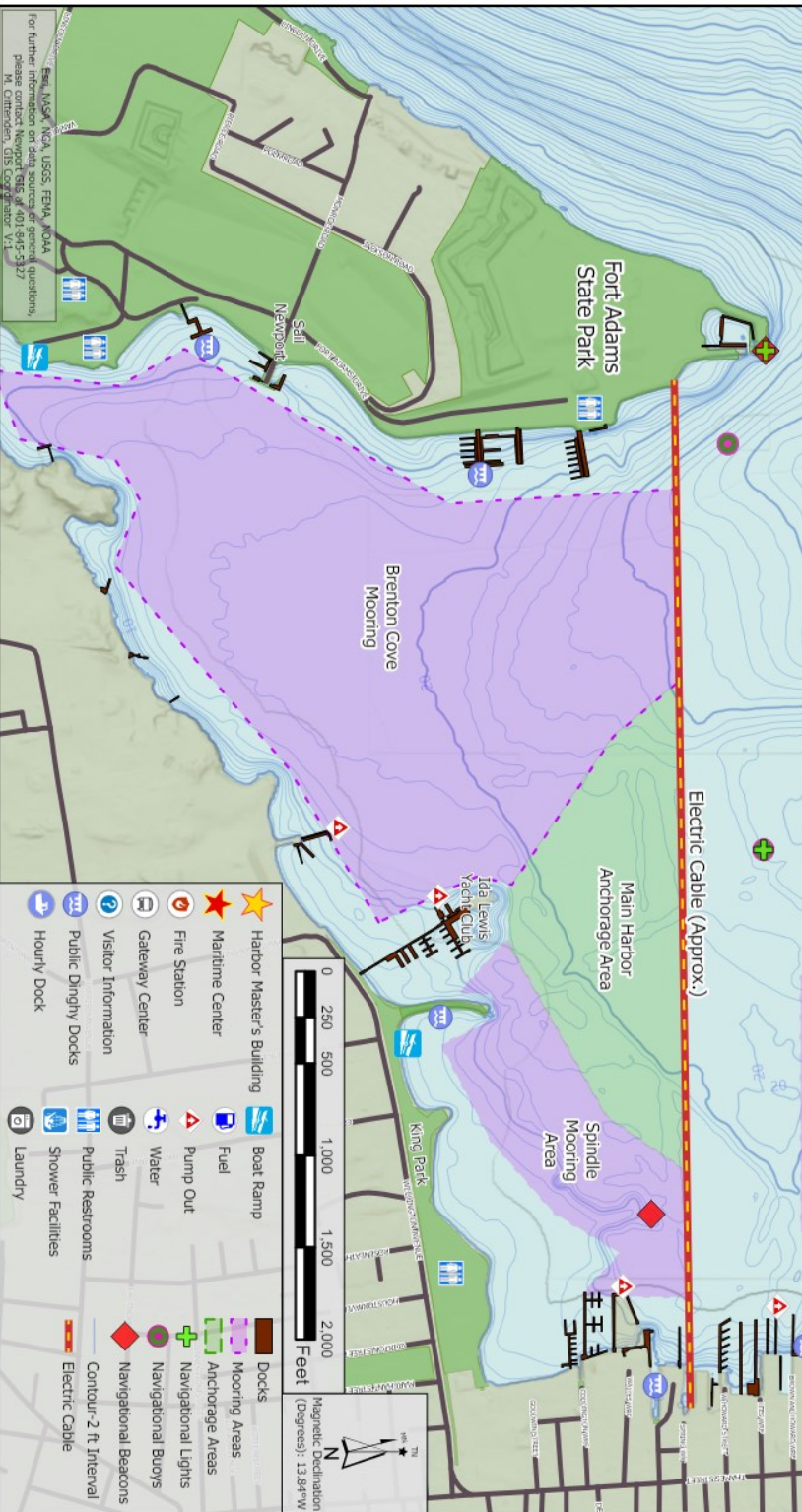

Important Points to Remember

- Quiet hours on the harbor are 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Speed limit is 5 mph (no wake)
- No discharge in Newport Harbor or Narragansett Bay

- Navigation Laws: US Code of Federal Regulations, "Rules of the Road", and State of Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management boating laws apply
