All requests and payments for bulky waste and white goods collection items can be made directly through the City's hauling company, Waste Management, by calling 1-800-972-4545.

Bulky Items including the following are collected every other Thursday by appointment only.

Bulky Items - such as couches, upholstered furniture, wooden furniture, mattresses, etc. The collection cost per item is \$31.50 White Goods/Appliances - stoves, refrigerators, dishwashers washers dryers, air conditioners etc. The collection cost per item is \$42

TRANSFER STATION INFORMATION

The Waste Management Transfer Station is open M-F 8 a.m. - $3:15\,$ p.m. (closed 11:45 a.m. - $12:30\,$ p.m. for lunch), and Saturdays from 8 - $11:45\,$ a.m.

Located at 65 Halsey Street, the station accepts everything except hazardous waste based on preset fees. Please note that the City of Newport does **NOT** own the transfer station. If you have questions about rates, please call Waste Management directly at **(401) 848-5450.**

Residential property owners only are allowed two free visits per fiscal year (July - June) of up to 500 lbs. per visit funded by the City. Note that a property tax or water bill AND a government issued ID or driver's license are required.



HOLIDAY COLLECTION DELAYS

H The Transfer Station is closed. New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Juneteeth, Independence Day, Victory Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. Collections following the above holidays will experience a one-day delay.

Denotes that City offices are closed but the Transfer Station is OPEN and NORMAL COLLECTION applies: Presidents Day (Feb. 17); R.I. Independence Day (May 5 observed).

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

collection weeks are shown on the 2025 calendar as shaded weeks one week in January, one week in March, four weeks in April, every other week May through October, three weeks in November, and one week in December. (There is no collection in February.) Waste Management will collect leaves, grass clippings and branches less than four inches in diameter (and no more than three feet in length) placed either in paper bags, tied in bundles, or in 32-gallon garbage cans. (Yard Waste Only stickers NOT required.) PLEASE NOTE: Any yard waste material placed in plastic bags will be left behind on the curbside.
